Joukamo-Ampuja has been a member of the Finnish Radio Symphony Orchestra during years 1984-2001, now being a Senior Lecturer of Horn in Sibelius Academy.

She is a well-known lecturer and a teacher, giving master classes, lectures and workshops in Scandinavia, Europe, USA and Australia. She is also an Adjunct Professor of Queensland Conservatoire, Griffith University, Brisbane since 2014. In other than teaching horn, Erja Joukamo-Ampuja has specialized also in physical and mental practicing and different practicing techniques. She is an active researcher and teacher in Music Medicine field in Finland. She is also giving creative improvisation- workshops to improve classical musician`s interpretation skills.
